What would I be doing if I became part of a Barnabas Team?

1. Reach out to a missionary in any way the Lord leads YOU to encourage and build him/her up.
2. Contact the missionary's Advocate and learn about the family and work of an Immanuel's supported missionary.
3. Pick up the missionary's monthly newsletter from the mission display.
4. Pray about how you can embrace and encourage your missionary as part of his/her team. Pray for your missionary.
5. Communicate either by e-mail or ground mail.
6. Send birthday and/or anniversary cards.
7. Have your children send a drawing or unblown balloons to your missionary's children on their birthday.
8. Invite your missionary to dinner when he/she is on furlough. Visit your missionary on the field or send gifts when others visit your missionary.
9. Share your outreach ideas with the Missions Task Force or your missionary's Advocate.

What is a missionary Advocate?

Each missionary has an "advocate." An advocate serves as the main point of contact between the missionary and Immanuel's Church. The advocate knows the details of the missionary's work and can share with you all the necessary information to begin a relationship with the missionary of your calling. Pick up a Missionary Newsletter from the mission rack in the rotunda and begin to pray and encourage a missionary today!
